## BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION Associate in Science

The Associate in Science, Business Administration program is designed for students preparing to transfer to a four-year college or university to pursue a bachelor's degree for employment in a variety of business careers, including accounting, finance, marketing, business administration, and management.

Students are required to take electives to explore different disciplines or to satisfy transfer requirements to four-year institutions. In order to assure an appropriate selection of elective courses, students are urged to meet with a career advisor before registering for courses.
