

## ADDICTION COUNSELING Certificate

The Certificate in Addiction Counseling program is primarily designed for those who have been previously academically prepared with a minimum of an Associate Degree or higher. This certificate will prepare students with the practical beginning skills needed to support the recovery of persons with addictive disorders. Completion of these courses will satisfy the certification requirements and prepares students for immediate career placement in the field of Addiction Counseling.

All courses may be applied to the Associate in Science in Addiction Counseling or the Associate in Applied Science in Addiction Counseling.
