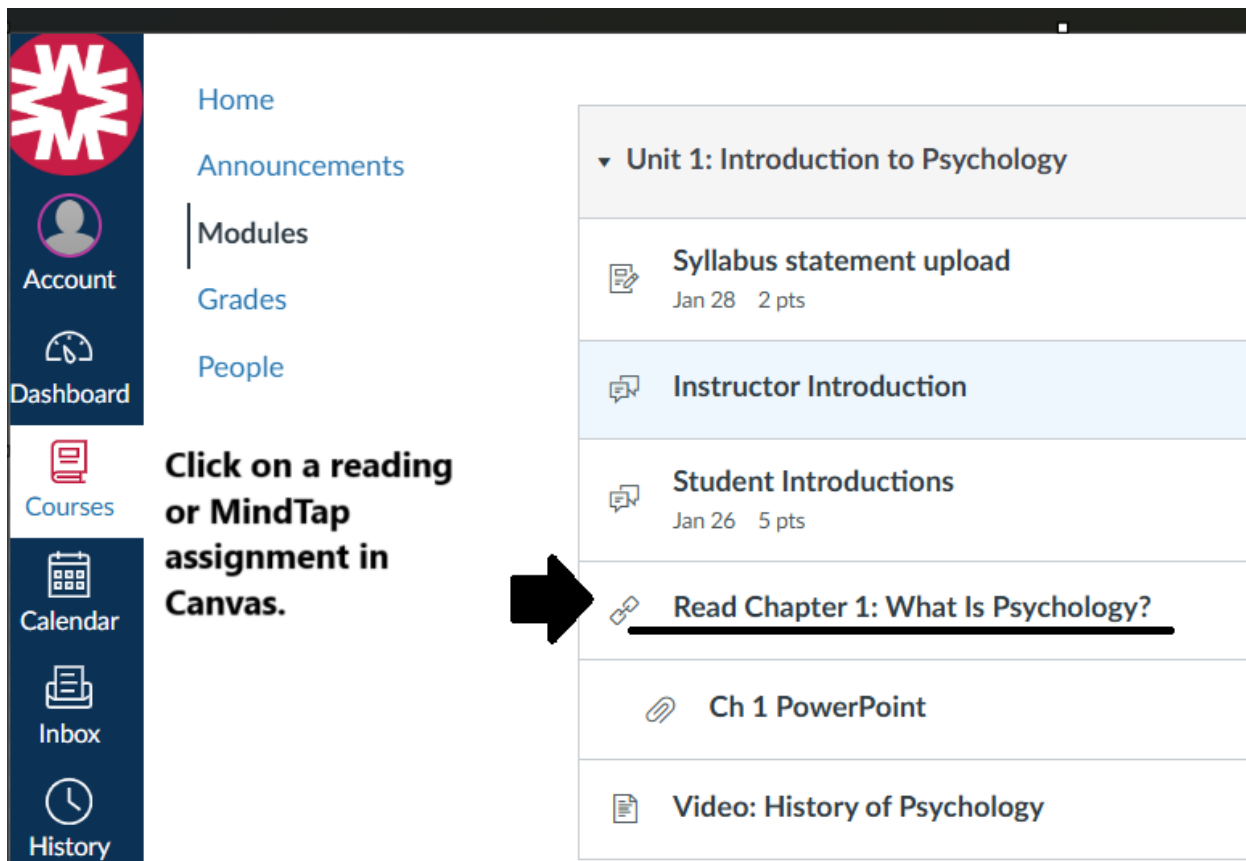


Cengage in Canvas

Beginning the spring 2025 semester Cengage will be accessed through Canvas. Being able to access Cengage through Canvas allows your instructors to directly link reading assignments and homework. Students no longer need to load their textbooks or worry about course keys. After you've linked the two accounts once, you will be able to access Cengage through Canvas in all your courses.

Linking Canvas and Cengage

To access Cengage for the first time through Canvas, go to any of your spring classes in Canvas and navigate to modules.

Returning Students

If you have previously taken classes at WCCC and have already created a Cengage account, you will not create a new account. You no longer need course keys to add your books to Cengage as long as you access Cengage through Canvas and not directly.

Do NOT create multiple Cengage accounts.

New Students

WCCC does not create an account for you with Cengage. You are responsible for creating your own Cengage account when you start classes. Each semester you will use the same account to access your textbooks.
