Application Process

- 1. File your FAFSA or NJ Alternative Application
- 2. Apply to Warren County Community College
- 3. Complete an EOF Application
- 4.Submit completed and signed application to eofp@warren.edu

I've Applied, Now What?

- 1. Once you've applied, you will receive an email prompting you to schedule an interview
- 2. After your interview you will receive and you've been accepted, you will receive a contract to complete and return as well as the next steps
- 3.You will then be invited to attend the EOF Summer Scholars program if you are a new WCCC student
- 4. Current Warren Students will be invited to an orientation session

- Gross income and assets must fall within the above criteria
- Demonstrate an educationally and economically challenging background
- Be a New Jersey Resident for 12 consecutive months prior to receiving the award
- Must apply and be accepted to Warren County Community College
- Must file Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the New Jersey Alternative Financial Aid Application
- Meet the academic criteria of Warren County Community College.
