

Nurse Education Application Instructions

IMPORTANT REQUIREMENTS:

- Your WCCC College Application *must* be on file *before* submitting an application to the Nurse Education Program.
- Your High School transcript or GED must be on file or be submitted to Student Services ASAP.
- You must attend a Nurse Intent Information Session (see www.warren.edu homepage for dates.) Virtual sessions are offered September and October 2023 and February, March, and April 2024. Also, posted on the website are on campus TEAS testing dates in Nov. 2023 and April 2024. Contact the Director of the Nurse Education program at pstypolkowski@warren.edu if you have missed all the Information Sessions.

Nurse Education Program Application

Deadline: May 1, 2024

Nurse Education Program applications are accepted from Friday, March 1 through Wednesday, May 1, 2024. Failure to submit on time may result in loss of eligibility. To apply:

- 1) **Submit the completed Nurse Education Program application ASAP.** This can be, prior to taking the pre-entrance exam and starting the **required** background check and urine drug screening process. Applications are submitted to the Student Services office (Room 117) during regular Student Services office hours.
- 2) **Request an official transcript:** If you have completed credits that you are using towards a nursing degree at another college, complete the *Request for Transcript* section of the application and request an official transcript, from your other schools, be sent to Student Services Dept.
 - If you have only attended WCCC, sign below the transcript section so that we can access your records.
- 3) **Get TEAS exam results:** If you have taken the TEAS exam at a location other than WCCC, please have ATI send your results to the Nurse Education Director, Patricia Stypolkowski at pstypolkowski@warren.edu.

Background Check and Urine Drug Screening screening process)

Deadline: May 1, 2024 (to begin

Please see the attached letter from **Adam Safeguard** for instructions. Background checks and urine drug screen **results** must be received by the Director of Nurse Education no later than **May 21, 2024**.

Acceptance Confirmation Deposit

Deadline: 1 week after acceptance

If accepted to the Nurse Education program, you will receive an acceptance notification via email on or about June 3, 2024. A \$250.00 non-refundable tuition deposit is due within one (1) week after notification to confirm your acceptance. These funds will be credited to your tuition and fee payments for the fall term. Your seat in class will not be held without the deposit.

Dear Student,

The Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations (JCAHO) now requires all healthcare students to have their identity verified and a criminal history search conducted prior to being allowed to participate in any cooperative educational program. In order to facilitate these requirements, Warren County Community College has engaged Adam Safeguard to provide necessary service.

The fee for the package selected is \$51 and includes a Social Security Trace, New Jersey Statewide Criminal History Search, National Criminal History Search, National Sex Offender Search and an OIG Sanction Search. Also, if an address in any state outside of New Jersey appears on your Social Security Trace, we are required to search that location as well for criminal history.

The fees for other locations are as listed below and are in addition to the package price above:

- NY - \$75
- PA - \$20
- All other state or county criminal history searches - \$10 each (plus court fees, if any)

In addition to the Student Background Check, you are required to complete a Urine Drug Screening. The Fee for the UDS required by your clinical is \$59 + NJ Sales Tax. Within two days after you have placed your order, you will receive an e-mail containing information to complete the specimen collection.

- You will be required to enter School Code: **wcccrn**
- Be sure to follow the process through until the third screen where you will receive your Order Number

PLEASE NOTE:

- The charges on your credit card will reflect the name **Adam Safeguard**.
- For those not utilizing a credit card you should complete the form, print it and send it with a bank check or money order to Adam Safeguard, 1187 Washington Street – Suite #2, Toms River, NJ 08754.

Because of the timeframe involved in the return of the NJ Statewide Criminal History Searches (10 business days) we ask that you do not contact Adam Safeguard with inquiries regarding completion of searches before the 10 day mark. Unfortunately we cannot inquire the status of these reports, nor can we expedite them in any way.

- If a discrepancy is located in your criminal history search, Adam will provide you with the necessary information regarding correct procedure on how to correct, admit, deny or dispute the claim(s).
- If a discrepancy is found in your Social Security Trace, we will provide you with the necessary information on how to identify and correct possible fraudulent activity.



Frequently Asked Questions:

- Will I be charged if I have lived outside of NJ? If so, how much?
 - With the Package selected by your educational institution, additional fees will be charged based on the fee schedule listed above.
- Will my prior arrest, criminal history, conviction, etc. show up?
 - We do not know what arrests, convictions, etc. will show up until the searches have been run.
- How long does the search take?
 - The search will take about 10 business days to complete if the record is clear. If a hit is recovered, it would take about two, even three weeks to come back depending on the availability of any additional information that may be required to obtain. Unfortunately we cannot expedite this process, nor can we contact the State Police for updates on results.
- What crimes/convictions/arrests will keep me out of the program?
 - The education and/or medical facilities will determine which applicants they will accept and deny based on the Background Report. Adam Safeguard does not have any authority to make these decisions.
- Who will have access to/see my report? My credit card number? My SS Number?
 - Adam Safeguard will have access to all three indicated above. The medical facility will have access to the reports, which will contain your SS Number.
- When/How will the school receive my report?
 - The education and/or medical facility will be directly linked to our system and they will be able to log in and view your report as soon as it is completed.
- What do I do if an arrest/conviction shows up on my report and it is not me?
 - Adam will provide you with information on how to dispute/deny/admit/correct any discrepancies in your criminal history. These are one page forms that can be found on our web site under “JCAHO Compliance”.
- What do I do if an address that isn't mine shows up on my Social Security Trace?
 - You may download a form from the web site listed above that will direct you on how to correct any discrepancies found in your Social Security Trace.
