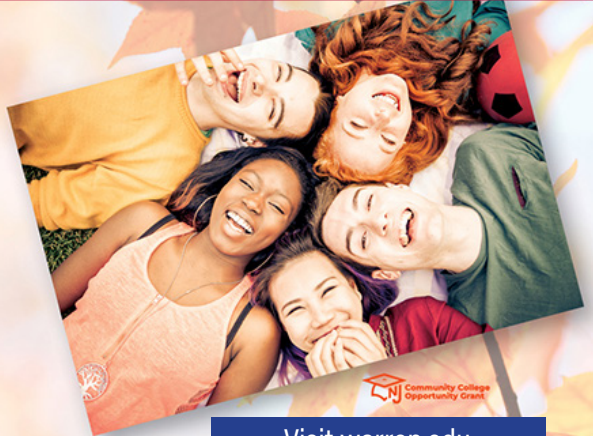

GRANTS (INCLUDING SCHOLARSHIPS)

Funds that do not have to be repaid. This includes Pell Grant funds and State Tuition Aid Grant funds (TAG).

TUITION-FREE COLLEGE (fall and spring semesters only)

EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITY FUND (EOF)

The New Jersey Educational Opportunity Fund (EOF) provides academic support services and financial assistance to students from educationally and economically disadvantaged backgrounds.
