MEET WITH AN ACADEMIC ADVISOR

Meet with an Academic Advisor to determine your next steps. The Advisor will work with you to determine course placement using various measures, such as SAT scores, college transcripts showing college level English and math courses, and/ or high school GPA. Bring a copy of your high school and college transcripts and additional documentation that may assist with appropriate placement.

A placement test or SAT is not required. Your next step is to register for classes. The Academic Advisor will assist you in selecting the appropriate courses to help you achieve your educational and career goals. No appointment is needed.
